

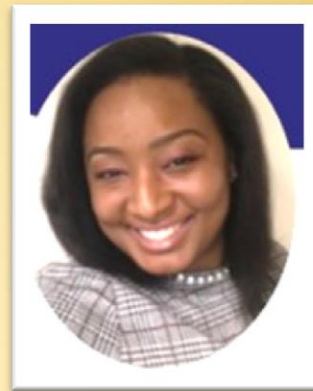
# A Historical Glimpse of the Young Adult Department
